2011-2012 Brebeuf Academic Year Highlights

- Sixty Grade 11 students participated in two Kairos retreats facilitated by student leaders, staff, and the Jesuit Fathers.
- Almost \$6000 was raised for the missions of the Presentation Brothers in Africa. Students also donated canned food for the Good Shepherd Refuge, clothing for the St. Vincent de Paul Society, and funds for Volunteer International Christian Service.
- The TCDSB spent \$40,000 to upgrade Brebeuf's Larry Uteck Memorial Field.
- Students and staff undertook a service and leadership trip to St. Lucia to work with the Presentation Brothers' project for students there who have been unsuccessful in school.
- The Brebeuf Bulls won Sports Championships in Table Tennis (Senior), Swimming (Senior), and Rugby 7s (Senior Finalists).
- **Darren Pereira '13** had the highest score in the TCDSB for the Canadian Mathematics Competition's Fermat Contest and Canadian Senior Contest. **Nicholas Liu '13** had the highest score in the TCDSB for the Cayley Contest.
- Almost fifty per cent of our graduates from the Class of 2012 were Ontario Scholars.
- Forty graduates were inducted into the Blessed Edmund Rice Society for being named to the Honour Roll for all four years of high school.

- Brebeuf students and staff led the annual Camp Olympia Leadership weekend for student leaders across the TCDSB.
- The entire school was outfitted with Wi-Fi, giving students and staff access to the internet via laptops and tablets.
- Students wrote Advanced Placement examinations in many subjects. Twenty-six students wrote AP Calculus and more than half got levels 4 or 5, earning them university credits. All students who wrote AP English Language and Literature got level 4 or above.

Longtime Brebeuf staff member Jacques Carron passed away in June, 2012. The following is a brief extract from the blog written by Mike Daoust '67 :

We gathered today to honour the memory of Jacques Carron. It was great to see former colleagues like Tom Sullivan, Peter Lee, Ailix Will, Joe Younder, Joe Brisbois and Shirley Gasperet as well as a number of Brebeuf grads. The service was concluded by the reading of Jacques' eulogy by his sister-in-law Judy in English and by good friend Andre in French. Hearing the text that Jacques and I worked on in his backyard three months ago reminded me of his courage, his generosity and his strength of character. Though he knew the end was in sight, he was determined to leave this world with dignity and grace.

"It's not often that you attend a memorial gathering and hear a eulogy that's been prepared by the deceased. But then again, you all know I was never your average guy.

I feel so fortunate to have had these last few weeks to put everything in order, to say my goodbyes, to share some good memories with friends, to enjoy my backyard, to play an evening game of cards with family and put a few of my thoughts into words as I close out my journey.

My message for all of you actually centers on two words; attitude and gratitude.

My two fisted attitude of confrontation that existed at the outset of my illness transformed into the open hands of acceptance, the acceptance of the will of God. He wants me to come home, a bit too early as far as I'm concerned but there's really no arguing with the boss is there?

A meaningful life is all about attitude. Let yours be one that wills the good of others, that sees the glass half full, that welcomes the rain as well as the sunshine, an attitude that says... Lord, Thank you for the gift of this day, May Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Life is all about gratitude and love. May I express my sincerest gratitude to all of you for your friendship, your kindness, your affection, your support. My life has been blessed with so many wonderful friendships. You've made me feel tremendously rich. Know that I will never forget you. I love you all from the depth of my heart.





Archbishop Philip Pocock Award Winner: Greg Rogers '72

Each year CARFLEO, the Catholic Association of Religious and Family Life Educators of Ontario, honours a Catholic educator with the Archbishop Philip Pocock Award for excellence in Religious Education in the province.

This year's recipient embodies what is foundational to Catholic education not just in his professional life but in his day to day living. The name Greg Rogers speaks for itself in the TCDSB. In a life dedicated to Catholic education, Greg has touched and shaped the lives of students and secretaries, parents and religious, superintendents and directors.

On the provincial stage, Greg is a founding member of When Faith Meets Pedagogy and is responsible for inaugurating and organizing the bi-annual Catholic Youth Forum which draws 1500 high school leaders to be inspired by the likes of Jean Vanier, Mary Jo Leddy and the Keilburger brothers.

In addition to his board responsibilities as Student Leadership and Staff Development Coordinator, Greg has collaborated and created curriculum and video resources with L'Arche Canada, the Catholic Curriculum Cooperation, and the Institute for Catholic Education. Most recently, he took a leading role in the launching of the revised Ontario Catholic Graduate Expectations.

Most notably, Greg empowers students through annual servant leadership courses and trips to Kenya, India, South Africa, Ghana, and the Philippines. These experiences expose students to cultural, religious, and economic diversity and apply social justice practices as a critical element to Catholic education. Greg knows the power of learning outside the box and outside the classroom. Ask any of the hundreds of Ontario Catholic students who have participated in the Catholic Leadership Camp at Olympia Sports Camp, and they will tell you of how real and relevant Greg has made Catholic education. The list of Greg's involvement goes on and on, as it does with any great leader who makes such an impact on people's lives. Truly for Greg, it has never been just about the importance of the work as much as it is about the importance of building relationships. No one has ever become a leader because they wanted to keep things the same! Greg's mark on Catholic Education in Ontario most certainly plays a significant and transformative role in the lives of people dedicated to living an active faith.

Greg received his award at the annual When Faith Meets Pedagogy Conference held in late October.



Editor's note: Greg Rogers '72 is both an alumnus of Brebeuf and a former staff member. In 1981-82 Greg lead the formation of a new organization at Brebeuf known as the Brebeuf Alumni Association. Thirty years later Greg is still making a tremendous difference in the lives of young students as he once did at Brebeuf.






