The Honour Roll recognizes students who have an overall average of at least 80% with no marks below 60%. These students bear positive witness to our motto, *Studio Gradum Faciant* ("Succeed Through Study").

Brebeuf Renaissance Awards are given to students who have been actively involved in all facets of school life: academics, athletics, service, and clubs.

The Catholic Student Award recognizes a student who has made a contribution to the religious life of the school.

GRADE IX

Ned Harrington Award is given to a Grade 9 student for outstanding performance in academics, school participation, and leadership.

Father Robert Meagher S.J. Award is given to the most academic Grade 9 student in honour of our first Principal and Founder.

GRADE X

Dr. Robert Lato '68 Award is given annually to the Grade 10 student who has shown the most improvement in his studies. This award is named for Bob Lato, an alumnus, teacher, guidance counsellor, and pillar of the Brebeuf community, 1968-2003.

Father Clement Crusoe S.J. Award is named for our Principal from 1972-1976 and is given to the student with the highest average in Grade 10.

GRADE XI

Father Kenneth Casey S.J. Award, named for our Principal from 1976-1979, is given to the student with the highest average in Grade 11.
