Dear Parents:

At this time I would like to bring to your attention the fact that Brebeuf's continuance is very doubtful simply because the school is in financial difficulties. Our revenues are not sufficient to pay the costs of operating the school.

If sufficient funds become available from whatever source, the school will continue its good work of offering your sons the opportunity for an excellent education.

In my letter of early February I advised you that the tuition fees would be increased for the school year 1972-1973. This increase will add to our revenues, but it will not completely solve our financial difficulties.

In September the Brebeuf Lay Advisory Board will launch a fund-raising project in the form of a lottery. The details of this project have not been finalized yet. We know, however, that its success will be another help towards balancing our books next year. But success will call for the fullest support of all concerned with Brebeuf's continuance, chief amongst whom are the parents of our students.

In closing I wish to assure you that your continued interest in Brebeuf and all its projects is deeply appreciated.
