- provision for operation of Gym and from residence for evening and week-end use. Cafeteria areas separate from school Maximum separation of this area
- (5) fully equipped science classrooms

#### Residence:

requirements:-Cloistered residence for Jesuit Fathers with following functional

- private rooms for 22 men
- lounge with small TV room
- 32E dining room and kitchen to be run by Brothers of Order
- 64
- chapel with sacristy and massing chapels maximum separation from, but access to school

## Structural System:

#### General

continuous precast concrete beams at line of window heads load bearing walls at exterior and interior corridor walls; in both buildings;

- heavy continuous beam used in school to emphasize larger openings and non-personal character of space use -
- lighter beam increased over windows in residence to indicate reduced scale, smaller windows and individuality of space uses -

open web steel joists and steel pan and slab at first floor, steel deck at roof

# Chapel & Library of School

single T slabs fully exposed and spanning from bearing walls with glass infill at ends of slabs;

# Chapel of Residence

solid cedar posts, beams and deck forming steeply pitched roof of sanctuary


face brick, exposed precast concrete lintel beams with fine white marble painted block throughout; chip face; windows redwood, sealed only; steel opening sash, copper sheet and battens. pitched roof of residence chapel in

## Interior Finishes:


School generally finished in painted block with all doors and trim in off-white; all doors in chapel teak with teak plywood and battens over. School chapel walls exposed brick with concrete T slab, birch; door frames painted (black) with recessed birch trim; ceilings acoustic grid throughout. painted


Residence corridor block. with painted frames (black) and recessed walnut trim. Bedrooms plastered. All doors walnut
















SECTION A-A through gymnasium and cafeteria
