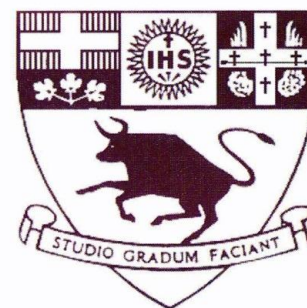

REACHING NEW HEIGHTS CAMPAIGN

The total cost of redeveloping Brebeuf was \$28.1 million. While the Toronto Catholic School Board and the Ontario Ministry of Education covered the cost of construction, the current budget does not make adequate provision for the furnishing and equipping of the new building.

This significantly limits our ability to update our programmes and to broaden the experiences available to our students. For example, we have six new science labs, but with equipment which is, in some cases, 40 years old. We enjoy a new 300 seat theatre, but do not have the light and sound equipment necessary to support the Theatre Brebeuf tradition. Our new library can accommodate 60 computer work stations, but we have 3 computers.

In the face of this challenge, we are turning to the Brebeuf community with a request for assistance and support.

The Alumni Association has responded to our dilemma with valuable advice and practical support. We have established the BREBEUF FUTURES FOUNDATION, a charitable foundation committed to supporting academic, spiritual, and co-curricular programmes at Brebeuf.

OBJECTIVES

- initiating the REACHING NEW HEIGHTS campaign to raise \$250,000
- ensuring a high quality of education to attract, support, and retain the best students and to provide an environment that fosters more personal teacher-student relationships
- maintaining a student population that reflects our society by ensuring that deserving students are not excluded from a Brebeuf education because of finances
- providing an excellent academic curriculum by attracting, supporting, and retaining competent and dynamic faculty who will make a difference in the lives of their students
- attracting successful students who will promote a challenging and stimulating academic environment
- evaluating and planning strategies to meet emerging and long-term priorities
